

# Stage 4 History Assessment Plan 2025

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Homework task completion
- Class participation discussions, Q&A
- Group work involvement
- Completion of class work and handouts
- Listening and responding tasks
- Reading skills in-class reading and comprehension of content from a wide variety of sources, analysis of sources.
- Writing skills: note-taking, text types report writing, letter writing, interview
- Speaking skills: oral presentation, interview
- Practical work physical analysis of sources

#### Term 2

## Term 4

• ICT presentation: transformation of Japan (HT4-2, HT4-4, HT4-6, HT4-7, HT4-9, HT4-10)
