

Stage 5 Visual Arts – Assessment Plan – 2025

Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Skill based and experimental work, using a range of materials.
- Techniques in 2D, 3D and 4D forms.
- Work produced in the student Visual Art diary.
- Class participation discussions, Q&A
- Completion of class work and handouts in relationship to the 3 Content Areas: Practice, Conceptual Framework & The Frames.
- Listening and responding tasks
- Application and understanding of key terms relating to Units studied.

Students will complete the following formal assessment tasks:

• Term 1: Ceramic Masks- 3D portraits Clay portraits, Cultural & Structural Frames Analysis. 5.1,5.3,5.4,5.6,5.7,5.9,5.10.

• Term 2: Representations of landscape. Canvas Landscape painting. Subjective & Structural Frames Analysis. 5.1,5.3,5.4,5.6,5.7,5.9,5.10.

• Term 3: The Built Environment & Surrealism Lino print and a Conceptual Frame-Work Analysis. 5.1,5.2,5.4,5.6,5.7,5.9.

• Term 4: Art on Wheels. Painted Skateboard and a Conceptual Frame-Works Analysis. 5.1,5.3,5.4,5.7,5.10.

As with all subjects, students will be assessed in relation to the NESA Common Grade Scale (A-E).
