Students will be continuously assessed in a wide variety of ways including:

- Skill based and experimental work, using a range of materials.
- Techniques in 2D, 3D and 4D forms.
- Work produced in a student Visual Arts diary.
- Class participation discussions, Q&A
- Completion of class work and handouts in relationship to the 3 Content Areas: Practice,
 Conceptual Framework & The Frames.
- Listening and responding tasks
- Application and understanding of key terms relating to Units studied.

Students will complete the following formal assessment tasks:

- Term 1: Ceramic Coffee Mugs
 Creation of clay coffee mug. Bisque fired & painted.

- Term 2: Still Life-Painting
 Still Life painting & submission of Frames analysis.

 Creating a lino print & submission of Frames analysis.

 Graffiti art on a 3D object.
