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2	1	Unit: Commedia dell' arte (25 hours)

	4	incorporates the use of mask, comedy and improvisation to explore character and scenarios.
	5	Students will create their own character mask, and perform a contemporary devised work
	6	using their mask.

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3	1	Unit: Scripted Drama (25 hours)
	2	Focus Outcomes: 5.1.3, 5.1.4, 5.2.1., 5.2.3, 5.2.2, 5.3.1, 5.3.2, 5.3.3
	3	Unit- Scripted Drama- students learn how to interpret and perform scripted drama, using
	4	production elements to enhance their final performance. Students will also review a play.
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	6	Major Assessment - Performance of a scripted scene and Theatre Review
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4	1	Unit: Creative Movement (20 hours)

	3	Students explore movement and physical theatre through the study of various practitioners,
	4	theatre companies and performance traditions. Students will create an original piece of
	5	drama demonstrating their knowledge and skills modelled off a chosen form or practitioner
	6	studied in the unit.
